- I previously provided a statement to the Commission of Inquiry dated 31 October 2023 (First 1. Statement).
- I adopt the same definitions as in my First Statement. 2.
- Paragraph 11 of my First Statement reads: 3.

"To date, the FSO Advisory Board has had no instances where a conflict has arisen."

- 4. This sentence was intended to convey that the FSQ Advisory Board has not, to date, had to resolve any issues as to conflicts of interest. Members on the FSQ Advisory Board and the Forensic Justice Sub-Committee have from time to time flagged a potential conflict of interest, usually in respect of matters going forward. However, these occasions have not, to my knowledge, required the FSQ Advisory Board to resolve the issue by either asking the member to recuse themselves or deciding not to ask for their recusal.
- For completeness, I wish to inform the Commission of Inquiry that there have been three 5. instances where a member of the FSQ Advisory Board, Dr Rebecca Kogios PSM, has raised a potential conflict of interest at a board meeting. She did so at each of the board meetings held on 28 March 2023, 4 May 2023 and 23 October 2023. Each of these potential conflicts of interest declared by Dr Kogios did not need to be resolved by the FSQ Advisory Board. The minutes of these meetings record the potential conflict of interest declared by Dr Kogios on each occasion.

All the facts and circumstances declared in my statement are within my own knowledge and belief, except for the facts and circumstances declared from information only, and where applicable, my means of knowledge and sources of information are contained in this statement.

I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the provisions of the Oaths Act 1867 (Qld).
